

ASSOCIATE PROGRAM DIRECTOR, Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLSc.) –
UBC DEPARTMENT OF PATHOLOGY AND LABORATORY MEDICINE

The Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine at the University of British Columbia invites applications for the position of Associate Program Director, Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science (BMLSc). The Associate Program Director will work with the Program Director to advance the BMLSc curriculum review and improvements. This will involve both educational leadership and academic service contributions. The successful candidate will also be responsible for course coordination and teaching (BMLSc and Vancouver Summer Program), as agreed upon with the Director. This appointment is for a one (1) year term with the possibility of renewal, subject to available funding.

The major objective of the BMLSc Program is to provide a high quality university program in the discipline of Medical Laboratory Science and in so doing, to expand and enhance the career and educational opportunities available to registered medical technologists and students of the life sciences. The Program is a highly regarded undergraduate science degree in the Faculty of Medicine. BMLSc students gain theoretical knowledge in a broad range of subjects in laboratory sciences as well as practical, hands-on experience in a variety of laboratory techniques.

In advancing the evidence-based BMLSc curriculum review and improvement efforts, the selected individual will work with the BMLSc Director, BMLSc Course Coordinators and Course Section Leads, Undergraduate Programs Coordinator, the Education Services Manager, BMLSc Teaching Technicians, and BMLSc students and alumni. Guidance will be provided by the Program Director and by the UBC Centre for Teaching, Learning and Technology curriculum consultant. Upcoming curriculum work includes curriculum mapping and redesigning and administering the graduate survey in order to collect the data necessary to inform strategic recommendations for targeted improvements. The Associate Program Director may also co-facilitate curriculum discussions with other Department members and with students and alumni in order to further delineate course inter-relationships and to advance improvements.

- PhD and/or MD in a medical laboratory science or related discipline or equivalent related experience;
- Formal training in education or educational methods;
- Familiarity with and teaching experience within the BMLSc Program;
- Experience in course coordination
- Interest in the scholarly approach to educational data collection and implementation of curricular change;
- Experience in committee work;
- Excellent interpersonal, oral and written communication skills;
- Strong commitment to and evidence of excellence in teaching;
- Demonstrated educational leadership potential
