

Poster presentation guidelines:

Posters must be able to be pinned to the poster boards (pins will be provided). Presenters are asked to hang their poster after the morning sessions according to abstract number as will be outlined in the program. Presenters are expected to be in attendance at their posters at their assigned time which will be announced closer to Path Day; for students in the Experimental Pathology program judging will also occur during this time. Please remove posters promptly at the end of the session.

Suggested Formatting Guidelines

1. Each poster may be a maximum of 3 x 4 feet, **portrait orientation only**. To avoid swinging below the poster board, restrict the length of your poster accordingly. **IMPORTANT NOTE:** Authors are asked to not exceed their surface allocation, as they will be encroaching on another author's assigned space.
2. Poster text and figures should be legible from a distance of one meter.
3. Each poster should have a label at the top that indicates the title of the paper, the name(s) of the author(s) and their affiliation(s). The size of the characters for the title should be at least 2.5 cm (1") high.
4. Drawings and charts should be clear and simple.
