Presenter Bio

John Andruschak

John began his clinical career as a Respiratory Therapist coming from Alberta. From 1979 to 1984 John was the RRT for critical care at the Royal Columbian Hospital. John left there as a Manager of the service to become the Manager of the Respiratory Therapy and Pulmonary Diagnostics departments at the Vancouver General Hospital (VGH). During the 10 year period, he held responsibility of a number of portfolios in Anaesthesia, Hyperbaric Medicine, Heart Cath, Non-invasive Cardiac Diagnostics at both VGH and University of British Columbia (UBC) hospitals and professional practice responsibility for Respiratory Therapy.

In 1990 John began working with the Vancouver Richmond Health Board, in Vancouver Community, as the Director of At Home Support Services, Adult and Infant Child and Youth Programs in South Vancouver as well as Aboriginal Health. In 1995 John moved to Fraser Health – White Rock South Surrey where he was responsible for Acute Services at Peace Arch Hospital and Community Programs in Mental Health and Public Health. John joined the Provincial Health Services Authority (PHSA) in 2005 as Director of British Columbia Reproductive Care Program and then moved to the PHSA Corporate office in 2007. There he became responsible for clinical and support services until 2009, when lower mainland consolidation strategies had him take on responsibility for the consolidation of Laboratory Medicine and Pathology.

Today John is a Vice President within PHSA with his primary file being the consolidation of Lab across the Lower Mainland as well as responsibility for Provincial Infection Control Network and Provincial Blood Co-ordinating Office.

Mick is currently part of the PHSA corporate business planning team supporting the Lower Mainland Laboratory portfolio. Since he joined PHSA 9 years ago he has been primarily supporting pathology and laboratory medicine.
