## Faculty Renewal

- The Department was very successful with the 1<sup>st</sup>two rounds of Faculty Renewal

## Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Science Program Report (BMLSc) – Dr. Amanda Bradley

BMLSc program will turn 40 in 2020

- 11 graduates this May
- Full class of 24 cohorts for 3<sup>rd</sup> year
- 132 applications for September 2019
- First student alumni faculty networking event this year was a success
  - 58 people in attendance
  - Will be a yearly event moving forward
- 4<sup>th</sup> year for Vancouver Summer Program
  - 32 international students typically attend

#### Safety Updates – Jennifer Xenakis

- Update of Supervisor training
  - There is a new handbook on the risk management services website which is <u>mandatory</u> for anyone who supervises or directs any staff
  - o Less than 30 minutes to complete
- 7 safety incidents since last departmental meeting
  - Medical Student will sit on safety committee to provide feedback

#### MD Undergraduate Education Program – Dr. Michael Nimmo

- Final year of the spiral curriculum; students that started 4 years ago are writing exams in May
- Students who have gone through the spiral curriculum have done better than previous years
- Ongoing quality improvement/feedback

#### General Pathology- Dr. Michael Nimmo

- Preparing for on-site survey in March 2020
- Program in BC has not been attracting candidates
  - o Demand has dropped for general pathologists
  - As there no residents the program will go inactive status as of July 1<sup>st</sup>.
  - We will not have an on-site survey from the Royal College

#### Anatomical Pathology - Dr. Brian Skinnider

- Since last departmental meeting 4 residents wrote and passed the Royal College Exam in May of last year
- 5 are writing this year
- Happy with CARMS match in January; 4 positions available, all filled



## Medical Biochemistry Residency Training - Dr. Sophia Wong

- 1 resident is in 5<sup>th</sup> year; waiting for results
- No applicants for this academic year
  - Trying to increase visibility
- Internal review took place in February; no official report received yet but positive feedback given

#### Medical Microbiology - Dr. Chris Lowe

- 5 residents in program; 1 will be writing Royal College Exam next month
- Successful in securing a candidate through CARMS (UBC Medical Student was chosen)
